WHAT IS THE ESTATE COMMITTEE?

The local management

The estate committee and the residents' meeting are the local management in the different housing estates. The estate committee is elected at the residents' meeting. The committee's job is to supervise the operation of the estate and to oversee that there is peace and order.

The residents' meeting

At the residents' meeting you and other residents can make important decisions about activities at the estate, house rules, maintenance and so on. This is where you as a resident can influence what is happening in your housing estate.

The residents' meeting is also where you vote on suggestions and proposals, for example about house rules, maintenance, green areas and so on.

Voice your opinion

You can voice your opinion by showing up at the meeting, and you always have the right to make suggestions for your estate committee to consider. This is one of the major purposes of the residents' meeting.
